4-H Agricultural Scholarship Bursary Criteria

Policy: The County of Peterborough, in each year shall consider the awarding of 4-H Agricultural scholarships in incremental amounts of \$250.00 to a total maximum of \$500.00 per year to eligible students.

An eligible student shall meet the following criteria:

1. Be a resident of the County of Peterborough (excluding the City of Peterborough) and
2. Must have successfully completed Grade 12 and be continuing with post secondary education in an agricultural-related field or in a field which can be used in the agricultural industry. A background in agriculture will be considered, including working on the family farm or on a volunteer basis.

Process:

1. Each year the Clerk's office will forward 4-H Agricultural Scholarship application forms to the schools attended by students in Peterborough County, to Township Clerks, local libraries, other groups with an agricultural focus such as the Agricultural Action Committee, the Federation of Agriculture, Fair Board Presidents, Cattlemen's Association, Trent University and Sir Sandford Fleming College.
2. Students must complete and submit the application form together with other required documents by the required date specified thereon.
3. A letter of recommendation from the Principal **must** accompany the application form.
4. A copy of the student's transcript shall be attached to the application form.
5. Students must be able to demonstrate a financial need for the 4-H Agricultural Scholarship.

The Awards and Bursaries Committee shall meet after the application deadline and recommend to Council the recipient(s) for the scholarship. The official announcement of the successful recipients shall be made at a Regular County Council Meeting and the successful recipients of the Award shall be invited to attend a Regular County Council Meeting at which time they will be presented with the bursary award.

Criteria:

The Committee shall take the following into consideration in making their awards and use the weighted ranking set out below:

1. The relative financial need of the individual (5).
2. The grade point average of the applicant (3).
3. The amount of other bursaries received (1).
