

**The Corporation of the
Municipality of Trent Lakes**

By-law No. B2018-010

A by-law to amend By-law No. B2016-029, 'A by-law to govern the proceedings of Council and Committees of The Corporation of the Municipality of Trent Lakes'

Whereas pursuant to Section 238 (2) of the Municipal Act, 2001, as amended, every municipality and local board shall pass a procedure by-law for governing the calling, place and proceedings of meetings;


And Whereas Council of the Municipality of Trent Lakes adopted By-law B2016-029 being, 'A by-law to govern the proceedings of Council and Committees of The Corporation of the Municipality of Trent Lakes';


And Whereas Council deems it desirable to amend By-law B2016-029;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Trent Lakes enacts as follows:

1. That By-law B2016-029 be amended by replacing subsection 1.(j) being the definition of "Meeting" with the following:
 - 1.(j) "Meeting" means any regular, special, or other meeting of a council, of a local board or of a committee of either of them, where a quorum is present, and where members discuss or otherwise deal with any matter in a way that materially advances the business or decision-making of the council, local board or committee.
2. That By-law B2016-029 be amended by adding the following four subsections at the end of Section 2.(b)(i):
 - (h) information explicitly supplied in confidence to the municipality or local board by Canada, a province or territory or a Crown agency of any of them;
 - (i) a trade secret or scientific, technical, commercial, financial or labour relations information, supplied in confidence to the municipality or local board, which, if disclosed, could reasonably be expected to prejudice significantly the competitive position or interfere significantly with the contractual or other negotiations of a person, group of persons, or organization;
 - (j) a trade secret or scientific, technical, commercial or financial information that belongs to the municipality or local board and has monetary value or potential monetary value; or
 - (k) a position, plan, procedure, criteria or instruction to be applied to any negotiations carried on or to be carried on by or on behalf of the municipality or local board.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and effect as of the 1st day of January, 2018.

Read a first, second and third time and passed this 9th day of January, 2018.
