An application for an entrance permit must be accompanied with an application fee of \$100.00 (includes processing, initial approval and final inspection) plus a deposit fee of \$750.00 (refundable after final inspection is approved). If a re-inspection is required, there is a fee of \$100 per visit (failure to comply with approval or final inspection).

The deposit fee will be refunded after the entrance has been installed as follows:

- 1. The culvert, if required, is set to the approved ditch grade.
- 2. Granular backfill is placed around the culvert and used to shape the entranceway.
- 3. Granular "A" type gravel to be used to top driveway.
- 4. The culvert size and entranceway width are as specified in the permit.
- 5. The roadside is left in a neat and tidy condition. Slopes must be neatly trimmed with topsoil and not steeper than 2:1. Culvert ends must be clean.
- 6. An entrance installed on a temporary permit is removed.
- 7. Only new C.S.P. will be accepted.
- 8. Entrance must be completed within two (2) years from the date of application, or deposit funds will be forfeited.
