

## Fees and Charges for the Disposal of Waste Municipality of Trent Lakes Transfer Stations

**Note: Maximum Load Size 2 yards<sup>3</sup> (per visit)**

Program / Category		Fees and Examples	
<b>Household Garbage</b>	Standard size clear garbage bag	26" x 36" which may include one privacy bag – <b>one marked square or \$1.00 per bag</b> Privacy bags (no larger than 12" x 14"). If privacy bag not included in clear garbage bag – <b>one marked square or \$1.00 per bag</b>	
	Large or commercial size clear garbage bag	<b>Two marked squares or \$2.00 per bag</b>	
<b>Furniture/ Bulky Waste</b>	Upholstered Furniture	<b>\$20 per item</b>	
	Large Bulky Furniture	Dresser, Armoire, Wooden tables etc. - <b>\$20 per item</b>	
	Small Bulky Furniture	Wooden chairs, coffee table, etc. - <b>\$10 per item</b>	
	Plastic Outdoor Furniture	<b>\$2 per item</b> if not bagged	
	Boats	Fibreglass boats - <b>\$100 up to 12 ft</b> , each additional 3 ft or part thereof <b>\$75</b> . Gas must be removed. Paddle boats/canoes/kayaks - <b>\$50 per item</b> Aluminum boats are <b>Free</b> under scrap metal.	
Hot tubs	<b>\$100</b>		
<b>Materials</b>	Construction & Demolition Material	<b>\$5 Minimum charge</b>	Building materials; Toilets, sinks, wood, flooring etc. <b>\$50 per yd<sup>3</sup></b>
	Shingles & Drywall	<b>\$5 Minimum charge</b>	<b>\$75 per yd<sup>3</sup></b>
	Concrete/Bricks	<b>\$10 Minimum charge</b>	<b>\$90 per yd<sup>3</sup></b>
	Mixed Load	<b>\$55 per yd<sup>3</sup></b> <b>Increasing to \$110 per yd<sup>3</sup> effective October 1, 2023</b>	
<b>Food Waste</b>	Organic Composting	<b>Free</b> disposal of kitchen /organic waste - Buckhorn Transfer Station only Backyard Composting is encouraged.	
<b>Yard Waste</b>	Brush	<b>Free</b> disposal at all Transfer Stations – maximum diameter stem/branch is 6 inches. No stumps.	
	Yard Waste	<b>Free</b> disposal at all Transfer Stations	
<b>Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)</b>	HHW	<b>Free</b> disposal - <b>Buckhorn Transfer Station only during seasonal HHW hours</b> (or year-round at 400 Pido Rd. Peterborough)	
<b>Limited HHW</b>	Household Batteries	<b>Free</b> disposal at all Transfer Stations	
	Car Batteries	<b>Free</b> disposal – <b>Bobcaygeon, Cavendish and Crystal Lake Transfer Stations only</b>	
	Fluorescent Tubes	<b>Free</b> disposal – <b>Bobcaygeon, Cavendish and Crystal Lake Transfer Stations only</b>	
<b>Blue Box Program</b>	Fibres	<b>Free</b> disposal at all Transfer Stations	
	Containers	<b>Free</b> disposal at all Transfer Stations	
<b>Tire Stewardship Program</b>	Tires	<b>Free</b> disposal at all Transfer Stations (maximum 10 tires per day)	
<b>Metal Recycling</b>	White Goods Appliances	<b>Free</b> disposal at all Transfer Stations <b>\$20.00 charge for Freon removal for refrigerators, freezers, A/C Units, dehumidifiers and water coolers.</b> All doors on refrigerators and freezers must be removed before disposal.	
	Scrap Metal	<b>Free</b> disposal at all Transfer Stations	
<b>WEEE</b>	Electronics	<b>Free</b> disposal at all Transfer Stations	
<b>Textile Diversion Program</b>	Textiles	<b>Clothing, footwear, linens, books, kitchenware, etc. - Free</b> disposal at all Transfer Stations	

**Note: Mattresses are not accepted at Trent Lakes Transfer Stations.**

Mattresses are accepted at Peterborough Waste Management Facility, 1260 Bensfort Road, Peterborough or Waste Connections, 348 County Road 6, Douro-Dummer, subject to their fees. Also watch for any mattress collection events.

**All loads brought to the Transfer Station must be tarped/covered.**
